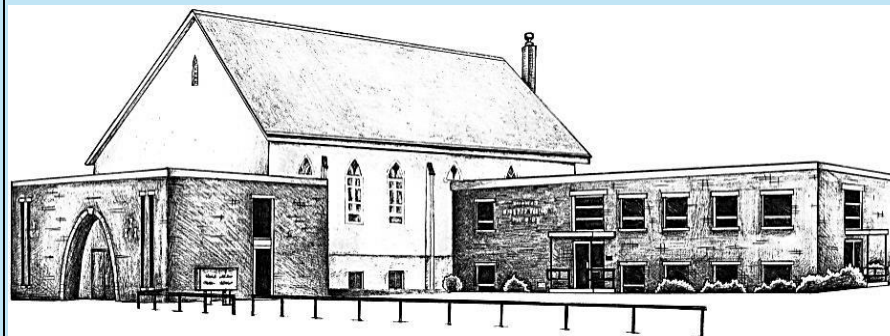

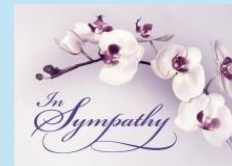
1. Our sympathies and prayers go out to the family and friends of **Luise Hirschfeld, age 91**, who passed away on **June 19**.
